Summary

Charlotte Groom was a member of the Red Cross Women's Service Corps in Western Australia for approximately 52 years. She was also a short-term member of the Voluntary Aid Detachment and one of Adelaide's first female stenographers.

In 1950, at the age of 83, Charlotte received a concussion in a bus accident, which saw a fellow Red Cross worker killed.
