IN 2008, Anne Davies is the Washington correspondent for the Melbourne *Age* and *The Sydney Morning Herald*. She will be covering the run up to the US presidential election in November 2008 and the first years of the new presidency. Previously, Anne was state political editor of *The Sydney Morning Herald*. Prior to that she was Urban Affairs editor, covering the development industry and local politics. During this time she and Kate McClymont won a Gold Walkley for their coverage of the Canterbury Bulldogs rugby league salary cap scandal. Anne also spent ten years covering Federal politics in Canberra and specialised in a number of policy areas including media, transport, industry policy and trade.
