Summary

Elizabeth Jackson began her career in journalism as a radio news reporter for Sydney's 2GB. In 1989 she joined the Australian Broadcasting Corporation (ABC) to work as a correspondent for ABC Television's *7.30 Report*. After two years she moved to Canberra as a reporter on ABC TV's *Landline* before making a move back to radio in 1994 becoming Breakfast presenter for Triple 6 ABC Canberra, then known as 2CN.

In June 1997 Elizabeth joined ABC Radio's News and Current Affairs department posting reports for their flagship *AM*, *The World Today* and *PM* programs.

Elizabeth has been producing and presenting *Saturday AM* since 2004. In December 2006 she took over as the Producer and Presenter of *Correspondents Report* on Radio National.
